# Child's progress

You are welcome at any time to approach your keyworker, or any other member of staff to discuss your child. Our job is to discuss any issues you have with your child's development and although each keyworker has between 6 and 9 children and may

not have the time to approach you every day with updates, you are welcome to approach them.

## Autumn parent meeting

The records that we write on your child are not started until they have been with us for 6 weeks. This is the same across the Foundation stage as the children are still 'finding their feet' and would not be a true account of their development. You can request a meeting with your keyworker with anything you would like to discuss. If your keyworker has any concerns at this time, she will have an informal chat with you.

#### Available information

Some of you were not sure of information on the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage). We have a lovely wallboard with photos explaining what our job is in the foundation stage and what we are teaching your children and we also have an information folder for you to take a look at in the back hall. If you would like more information let us know and we can source some for you.

### Boisterous boys

The boys are into playing superheroes, power rangers and share ideas and games really well. There are moments when it gets a little silly and these are dealt with swiftly and gently.

## Phonics, shapes etc.

This is being done at schoolwork and is age and developmental appropriate. We are here to get your children ready for Reception class and they will do this more in depth at school.

# Outside area and growing things

This is a great time of year for gardening, so we look forward to planting and watering! We make the best of outside as much as we can even though we would love a bigger space.

# Collecting artwork

Unfortunately we do not have the space to keep the children's work for a week. The children are very proud of their work and want to take it home on the same day. It is, of course, your choice if you wish to take it.
