Starting back at Playwell

We will be open from Monday 1st June if the government feel that the 5 key stages are met, but to work within the social distancing rules we are limiting the number of children allowed in the setting at any one time.

Children who are heading off to Reception class in September (date of birth between 1st September 2015 and 31st August 2016) will only be able to attend until the guidelines change.

Parents will be asked to wait for entry to maintain distancing rules, the door will be open until 9.20. Only 1 parent per child will be allowed into the setting. Parents will also be asked to keep to a one way system when entering the setting. When collecting your child we will send him/her out to you to in the playground avoid congestion

Playwell will be running normal sessions, where children can play with their friends in all rooms. Social distancing will be difficult to maintain with young children.

If your child is staying for lunch, please provide the lunch in a plastic box (so can be wiped clean), or a clear plastic bag (which can be thrown away). PLEASE DO NOT PROVIDE A LUNCH BAG.

Please remember to stick to guidelines regarding symptoms. If any member of the household has symptoms, please do not bring your child to Playwell. We need to keep everyone safe.

Hand washing and cleanliness will be maintained.

Cooking and playdough will not be available to the children and we will not be sending work home.

Staff will not be wearing face masks.

We will still be having lots of fun too.
