# Applying for reception

If your child's date of birth is between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018, you will need to apply for a place for Reception class for September 2022.

The closing date for applications is 15th January 2022.

#### Extra sessions

If you would like your child to have extra sessions in January can you please let us know as soon as possible. Afternoon spaces are extremely limited but please let Julie know your requirements and she will try to accommodate you. If you are accessing the 30 free hours for





the first time next term, you must apply now and give Julie the code before the beginning of December.

### Covid symptoms

Please do not bring your child in if they have covid symptoms – high temperature, cough. Covid is still around and we need to protect our Playwell community and our families.

Please call or text us if your child won't be attending Playwell and we may well ask you to test them before they come back to pre-school.

#### Lunchtimes

For new lunchtime parents; If your child is staying for lunch, we ask that you provide a healthy lunch with no sweets.

You do not need to provide a drink as we have milk and water available so please do not bring in water bottles. If you really must bring in a water bottle, please make sure that it fits into the lunch bag.

No peanut butter, no nuts and no eggs as we have children with allergies, could we also ask that grapes and tomatoes are cut in half as they are a choking hazard.

If your child has a yoghurt in a pot please provide a spoon.

We do have to fit 25 lunch boxes into the fridge, so can we ask that rucksacks are not used as lunchboxes.

## Bags and coats

You do not need to bring in bags for your child unless your key worker has asked to bring extra clothes in. If you do bring in a bag, please leave it on the table in the hall.

Please provide your child with a coat as we do go outside every day and please name your child's coats, jumpers and cardigans. It can be very difficult when a child wants to go outside and we can't find their coat and they can't remember what it looks like.

Can we remind you that the children's work is on the table for you to take home with you. Please take a look when you collect your child.

All of the newsletters and letters that we give to you are on the website and daily updates of the children's learning is posted on facebook. We post photos too, so please like us.

Term dates and other important information is on the website as well as on the 2 notice boards, please check them regularly, just in case you think that you have missed something.
